3. Earman River Shoreline Regulations:

The Village has received fill permits for properties along the Earman River that are attempting to protect their properties. The Village has no regulations regarding the appropriate way to treat the shoreline. Village staff has received input from the Environmental Committee, but is requesting input from the Waterways Board before developing an ordinance for Village Council consideration.
4. Yacht Regulations:

Residents have requested that the Village Council consider establishing regulations for large yachts within Village waterways. Board dialogue and input is requested on issues to evaluate when considering regulations based upon the size of a vessel will be requested.
5. Lozman Floating Structures:

Information only. The floating structure has been issued a Notice of Intent to Impound.
6. Future discussion: Anchorage Park Marina South

Following a decision to install floating docks on the north side of the Anchorage Park Marina, Village Council directed staff to closely compare the costs/benefits of installing

fixed docks with lifts to floating docks on the south side. This will be a discussion item later in the fiscal year as staff prepares to develop a scope of work for the design of a new seawall and docks for the south side next fiscal year (FY2022-2023).
