FIRE Safety Tips

Smoke Alarms

- There are hardwired, inter-connected Smoke Alarms inside and outside of every bedroom

Have a Fire Escape Plan

- Identify 2 ways to escape from each room



- Crawl on the ground if there is smoke
- Touch door, if it is hot, DO NOT OPEN
- Plan a place to meet outside

If your clothes are on fire

STOP Do not move or run, air feeds fire

DROP to the ground

ROLL to put out the fire



Home Safety Tips

Electric

- Do NOT plug too many cords in one outlet
- Keep cords away from water
- Replace cords when broken, DO NOT use tape



Cooking

- Keep towels and paper away from stove top
- NEVER use water on a grease fire, cover with a lid
- Turn ALL burners OFF when not in use
- NEVER leave home with the stove on



Outdoor Grills

- Keep away from buildings
- Must always be watched
- After use, close lid until the grill and coals have cooled



Pool Safety Tips



- Always watch kids in and around the water
- Keep children away from pool drains
- Know how to perform CPR on children and adults

Severe Weather

In case of Severe Weather



- Beware of power outages
- Have plenty of batteries for your flashlights
- In case of immediate danger, move to a hallway or place in the house with no windows
- Use blankets to protect you from flying glass

In case of Hurricanes

- Check your supplies, make sure you have blankets, first aid, batteries, flashlights, radios, pet care items and enough water for 3 days for each person in the house.
- Figure out an evacuation route in case you need to evacuate
- Closely monitor media reports as the storm approaches and follow instructions from public safety officials
