APPLICATION FOR FILL PERMIT

Sec. 7-16. - Required.

(a) No person may make or deposit any fill or undertake the filling, creation or extension of land by pumping, dredging, pumping sand, rock or earth or otherwise within the water of Lake Worth or other tidal waters within the limits of the village without first having received a permit therefor from the village council. All filling shall be made in accordance with the plans and specifications designated in the application for such permit. (b) Notwithstanding the foregoing, a fill permit shall not be required for any fill associated with the replacement or reconstruction of an existing seawall or bulkhead no more than eighteen (18) inches waterward of the property line as provided in section 5-72(1) of this code.  - Lake name.
 - A north arrow.
 - Bottom elevations or water depths.
 - The dimensions of the property (including total linear feet of shoreline at the NHWE).
 - Existing structures and proposed alteration areas with dimensions in feet or square feet.
 - The location of the requested work with respect to the upland owner's property and adjacent properties.
 - A description of sedimentation and erosion control measures used during construction.
- A property survey or have the alteration areas drawn to scale on a survey.
- If project is for new seawall where no wall has existed and there is no wall on either adjacent property, the applicant must demonstrate that there is significant erosion and that a vertical seawall is the only practicable method available to stabilize the shoreline. To demonstrate this, a letter from a registered professional engineer shall be required.
- Outside agency approvals such as South Florida Management Department, etc.
- Chapter 2019-125.022, Florida Statutes (House Bill 7103), establishes timeframes for applicant and agency responses. By checking this box, you are providing written authorization for the Village to waive the mandatory timeframes established by law.
