Enjoy live music from the North Palm Youth Symphony, plus, we'll have a native tree giveaway, face painting, and exciting children's activities.



Bring your painted birdhouse, but please make sure it's suitable to safely attract our local feathered friends!

Reconstruction of the Anchorage Park boat ramp began February 10 and has an anticipated completion date of May 30 (weather permitting). The ramp will remain closed throughout the construction process.

The old ramp experienced significant wear and tear, including a failure at the low end, making boat loading and unloading increasingly difficult.

This project will install a modernized, reinforced replacement that meets today's standards while ensuring a positive experience for boaters for years to come.

While temporary closure of the ramp during construction may pose an inconvenience, this project is needed to preserve this important Village resource.



## Follow Easter Bunny's fire engine ride using Rabbit Route map and social media

The Easter Bunny returns on a fire engine again this year on Saturday, April 19. He'll leave the fire station at 9 a.m. and visit every street in the Village.

It will take him a few hours, so the best way to know when he's coming near to your street is to listen for his sirens and come outside when you hear him approaching.

### Track the Bunny on Google Map

Use our Rabbit Routes and Bunny Zones map posted on Village social media to find your street and to see what "RR" or "BZ" you are in.

Our real-time posts will tell which RR or BZ the fire engine will travel to next, so you get a good estimate of where he is.

## Residential bulk pickup is done by appointment only

All residential pickup of bulk items in the Village is done only by appointment, but you don't need to be there when our pickup crew arrives.

To schedule a bulk appointment, visit the Village website at [www.villageofnpb.org](http://www.villageofnpb.org), then click the link for "Trash & Bulk Pickup." Fill out the brief online form to schedule your appointment.

This applies only to bulk items, such as old furniture and appliances. Vegetative yard debris is not a bulk item and will be picked up whenever left in the swale by the property's occupant.

Vegetative debris left by for-hire landscaping crews must be removed by the company.

Debris cut by the resident or homeowner must be put in the swale, clear of powerlines, trees or other obstructions.
