Sec. 17-34.13. - Marking of Commercial Vehicles

(a) It shall be the duty of every person doing business within the village, to have each and every truck or other vehicle used on a job within the village painted with or otherwise display the name of the person owning same, together with the business address, and the telephone number of the place of business. (b) Each such vehicle shall be lettered either on the door or on the body in such a manner as to be legible.



Police Department: Target Hardening Tips



The North Palm Beach Police Department would like to remind residents that when preparing to leave your home for an extended period of time it is important that you take necessary steps to safeguard your property from potential burglars. If you will be out of town, make sure that all vehicles are parked inside a closed garage if possible. If this is not possible, leave vehicles in a conspicuous location and remember to lock all windows and doors and remove all property. To safeguard your homes, make sure that any exterior lighting is in operation during the overnight hours as well as ensuring that all exterior doors and windows are locked. If your home is equipped with an alarm system, check to make sure it is operating properly prior to setting it. It is also a good idea to ask a friend or neighbor to look after your home when you are away and have them periodically check the property to make sure all is in order. You can make arrangements with the post office to suspend delivery to your home for specific dates. Burglars will often look to see a collection of mail and/or packages at the front door and use that as a sign that the resident is away and the house is an easy target for a burglary. These helpful tips are considered target-hardening and should become a regular practice when preparing to leave your home.
