

# NORTHLAKE BOULEVARD WATER AND SEWER FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT NEWSLETTER

This project is critical to ensuring the long-term reliability of the water and wastewater infrastructure. The goal of this newsletter is to enhance community awareness and keep our customers apprised of project progress through ongoing construction updates. This newsletter is updated periodically and posted on the Seacoast Utility Authority website linked above.

## What's Happening On-Site

- Lanzo Corporation (the Contractor) has continued construction requiring the use of lane closures. Pipe installation and restoration work have progressed in the westbound lanes of Northlake Boulevard between Southwind Drive and Northlake Drive.

## Looking Ahead

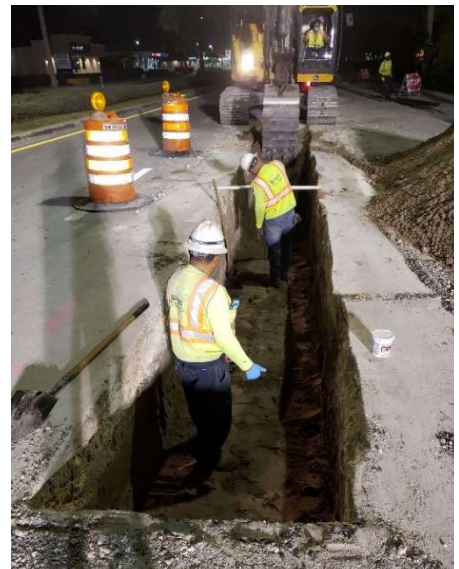
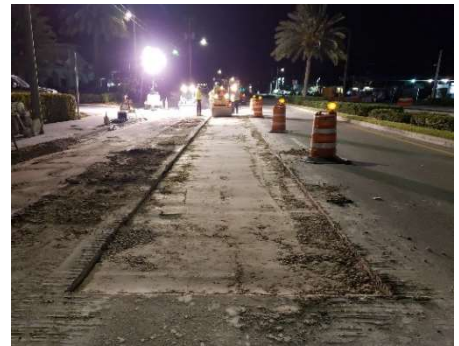
- Pipe installation will continue in the westbound lanes of Northlake Boulevard between Northlake Bridge and Prosperity Farms Road, and along Northlake Drive.
- To allow for pipe installation, **Northlake Drive will be closed to thru traffic the week of April 6<sup>th</sup> thru April 10<sup>th</sup>, between Northlake Boulevard and Eagle Way.** Limited access will be provided for adjacent property owners and residents.
- Pipe installation and restoration work will require nighttime lane closures (8pm to 6am) at the below two intersections over the next two weeks:
  - Alternate A1A & Northlake Boulevard intersection, the week of April 6<sup>th</sup> thru April 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Prosperity Farms Road & Northlake Boulevard intersection, the week of April 13<sup>th</sup> thru April 17<sup>th</sup>
- Work consists of trench excavations within the roadway and sidewalk for the installation of a new water main and sewer force main, followed by restoration. Pipe installation takes place primarily at night, with restoration work primarily during the day.
- Daytime lane closures are limited to a single lane. Nighttime lane closures include the closure of two lanes. See map on next sheet for further lane closure information.
- The next newsletter will be issued April 20, 2020.

## Schedule

- Work is planned to continue until approximately October 2020.

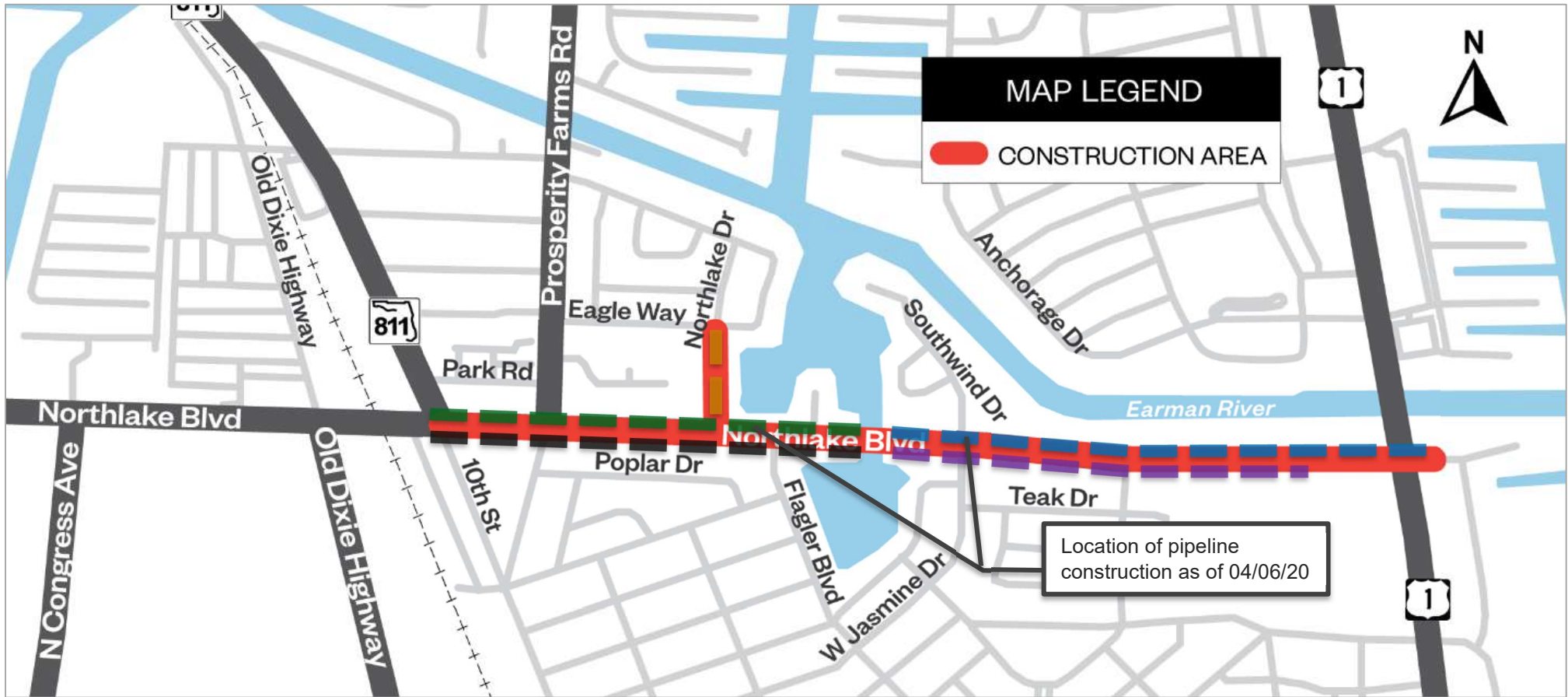

## Construction Area

The Seacoast Utility Authority is upgrading water and sewer infrastructure along Northlake Boulevard from Alternate A1A / 10th Street to US-1. The map below illustrates the construction area, along with the location and approximate timing of the project's primary lane closures. Additional, shorter-term lane closures will also be required throughout the construction area.



## Primary Lane Closures

- Eastbound Northlake Blvd., Alt. A1A to Northlake Bridge: January 2020 thru March 2020
- Northlake Drive: April 2020
- Westbound Northlake Blvd., Alt. A1A to Northlake Bridge: March 2020 and April 2020
- Westbound Northlake Blvd., Northlake Bridge to US-1: April 2020 thru June 2020
- Eastbound Northlake Blvd., Northlake Bridge to US-1: July 2020
