What's Happening On-Site

- Lanzo Corporation (the Contractor) has completed the project's primary construction work, including final restoration of the roadway.

Looking Ahead

- Short-term localized surface restoration work will continue in various locations throughout the project corridor within sidewalks and adjacent properties. Final striping of the roadway will be performed at the end of December.
- Lane closures for striping of roadway should be expected.
- No further impacts to water and sewer service are expected.

- Field work is planned to be completed by the end of December 2020.





Construction Area

The Seacoast Utility Authority is upgrading water and sewer infrastructure along Northlake Boulevard from Alternate A1A / 10th Street to US-1. The map below illustrates the construction area. Primary, along with the location and approximate timing of the project's primary lane closures.



Remaining Lane Closures

Short-term lane closures will be required throughout the construction area through the remainder of the project.

Daytime lane closures currently include the closure of a single outside lane.

Nighttime lane closures, when used, may require closure of two lanes.
