

# Second public Open House event planned for Oct. 26

The Village will hold a second public Open House meeting to inform residents about proposed redevelopment code changes and other major issues facing the Village. Topics include:

- Changes to the Village development code, which regulates the design and use of commercial properties.
- A proposal to re-purpose lanes on U.S. Highway 1 for increased landscaping, pedestrian and bicycle usage. This involves reducing part of U.S. Highway 1 to two lanes in each direction, instead of three, as it is now. Staff will be available to explain the benefits of the change and to answer questions from residents.
- A proposal by a private firm to develop vacant property at 200 Yacht Club Drive (across from the Country Club).
- Reconstruction of the U.S. 1 and Prosperity Farms Road bridges over the Earman River.

## Village Police Department offers tips for a safe Halloween

The Village Police Department wants to make sure that Halloween is safe this year for everyone. Here are a few tips to keep in mind:

- Small children should always be accompanied by a parent or other designated responsible adult.
- If parents decide older children can go trick-or-treating without adult supervision, they should make sure the kids travel in a group.
- Keep in mind that most trick-or-treating is done after dark so plan on bringing a flashlight or glow stick to illuminate your pathway and show others that you are in the area.
- Reflective outer clothing is always a smart choice when preparing for the evening.
- Have a designated route that is planned ahead so that you and your trick-or-treaters are familiar with the area.
- Remember to obey the rules of the road and take into consideration that it may be dark and harder for motorists to see you.
- Remind children to only visit the homes where there is an exterior porch light on or where it is known that the home participates in trick-or-treating.
- Educating children not to go inside a stranger's home nor eat any treats before returning home are also good ideas.
- Put down electronic devices and keep heads up when crossing the street.

# After a storm, let's stay in touch ...

If phone lines, cell phones and the Internet are not working after a hurricane, look for brochure distribution boxes temporarily mounted on street light and telephone poles in neighborhoods throughout the Village (see locations below). The boxes will be put in place **AFTER a serious storm** if other means of communication are not working, and will have updated information to help residents stay informed about recovery operations.



# BE HALLOWEEN Safe

Halloween is a fun, and spooky, time of year for kids. Make trick-or-treating safe for your little monsters with a few easy safety tips.

## HALLOWEEN FIRE SAFETY TIPS

- »» **When choosing a costume**, stay away from long trailing fabric. If your child is wearing a mask, make sure the eye holes are large enough so he or she can see out.
- »» **Provide children** with flashlights to carry for lighting or glow sticks as part of their costume.
- »» Dried flowers, cornstalks and crepe paper catch fire easily. **Keep all decorations** away from open flames and other heat sources like light bulbs and heaters.
- »» **Use a battery-operated** candle or glow-stick in jack-o-lanterns. If you use a real candle, use extreme caution. Make sure children are watched at all times when candles are lit. When lighting candles inside jack-o-lanterns, use long, fireplace-style matches or a utility lighter. Be sure to place lit pumpkins well away from anything that can burn and far enough out of the way of trick-or-treaters, doorsteps, walkways and yards.
- »» **Remember** to keep exits clear of decorations, so nothing blocks escape routes.
- »» **Make sure** all smoke alarms in the home are working.
- »» **Tell children** to stay away from open flames including jack-o-lanterns with candles in them. Be sure they know how to stop, drop and roll if their clothing catches fire. (Have them practice, stopping immediately, dropping to the ground, covering their face with hands, and rolling over and over to put the flames out.)

If your children are going to **Halloween parties** at others' homes, have them look for ways out of the home and plan how they would get out in an emergency.

Decorations are the first thing to ignite in **800** reported home fires each year. More than one-third of these fires were started by a candle.

# Using Anchorage Park boat ramp? Resident decal required

North Palm Beach residents can now purchase their Anchorage Park Marina Boat Ramp decal online. Decals are good through Sept. 30, 2021, and will be mailed to the applicant's home address.

The purple decal for 2019-2020 expired on Sept 30, and new decals for 2020-2021 are dark green.

Ramp users must affix their new decal to the back bumper or back window of the towing vehicle to use the ramp.

To register online, look for the "Boat Ramp Decal" link on the Village website ([www.village-npb.org](http://www.village-npb.org)). A username and password are needed, so please call the office first at (561) 841-3386.

Instructions to email proof of residency and towing vehicle registration are detailed on the online receipts.
